The Music Director will be responsible for directing the congregation in glorifying God in corporate worship through music. They would be responsible for overseeing the musical programs, recruiting/leading volunteers in the music ministry, organizing special events, and coordinating and planning production of worship services in partnership with the Lead Pastor. Woodlawn is looking for faithful and equipped individual to serve Christ's church in fulfilling the Greatest Commandment and Great Commission.

Qualifications:

- An authentic, personal, and growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Someone rooted in Bible reading, study, prayer, corporate worship, and sanctification in all areas of their life.
- A leader with a deep theological understanding of the scriptures, agreeing with the Baptist Faith & Message 2000 and the churches Statement of Essential Beliefs (WBC Constitution & Bylaws, Preamble III).
- Someone who, by nature of the requirements of the role, meets at minimum the Biblical qualifications of a deacon (1 Timothy 3:8-13), including being:
 - A devoted spouse of one (if applicable) (1 Tim 3:12)
 - A devoted parent (if applicable) committed to discipleship (1 Tim 3:12)
 - Spiritually mature (1 Timothy 3:9,11)
 - Worthy of respect (1 Timothy 3:8)
 - Trustworthy in action and speech (1 Timothy 3:8,11)
 - Self-controlled (1 Timothy 3:8,11)
 - Above reproach/Blameless (1 Timothy 3:10)
- A servant's heart to counsel, equip, and lead people of different ages, backgrounds, and cultures with humility and compassion.
- A strong musician with vocal and instrumental ability.
- Strong technical skills and the ability to learn and adapt to different equipment and technology.

Preferred Qualification:

- Previous Music Ministry experience in a Southern Baptist church, or theologically similar setting.

- High school diploma with collegiate level Biblical foundations or equivalent training in the local church.
- Experience with technology related to congregational worship (i.e. SongSelect, CCLI, ProPresenter, Planning Center, etc.).

Commitment To:

- Join the membership of this church and agree to uphold our church's covenant and statement of faith. All believing family members will also join the membership of our church.
- Participate in all areas of congregational life in the church, including but not limited to fellowship, evangelism, and worship (i.e. Sunday School, Wednesday Bible Study, Small Groups, etc.) on regular basis.
- Leading congregational music through a theologically rich blend of the Psalms, traditional hymns, and contemporary hymns/songs (i.e. Sovereign Grace Music, Matt Boswell, CityAlight, Austin Stone Worship, etc.).
- Recruit and lead church musicians, singers, and choir, working in a supportive role with the Lead Pastor to nurture discipleship and worship and to provide leadership in music ministry (media, choir, instrumentals, etc.).
- Submit annual proposed budget to Finance Committee in October for following fiscal year with authority to spend approved budget toward music ministry expenses.
- Organize and plan production in conjunction with the Lead Pastor and Media Ministry, providing information and materials to support congregational worship.

Woodlawn Baptist Church will provide compensation on a part-time status, based on experience and qualifications.
